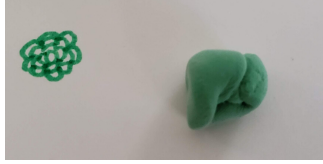
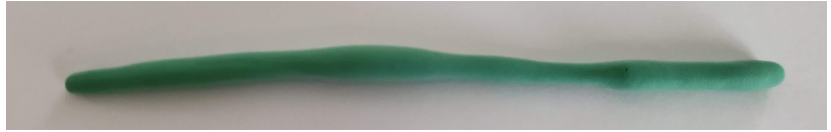


Mini Succulent Garden

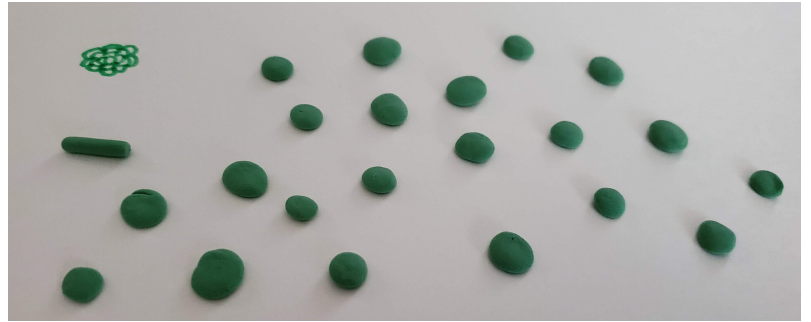
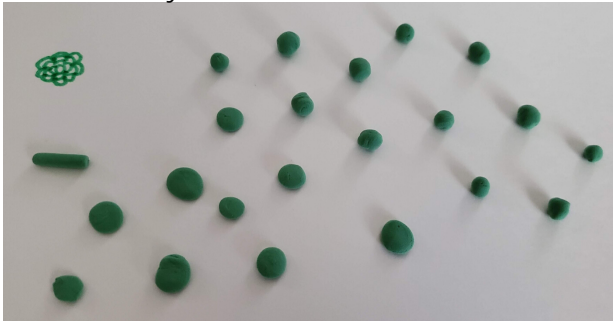
Take & Make



Roll clay in hands to soften.

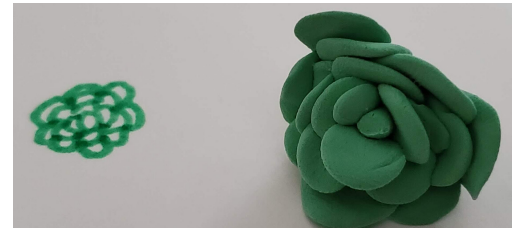


When soft, roll in to a log.



Roll 1 piece in to a log about 1/2 inch long, roll small pieces in to balls.

Flatten balls to petal shapes.



Attach petal pieces around stem.

Roll clay in hands to soften.

When soft, roll in to a long skinny log.



Cut in to about 12 pieces.



Select one piece for stem and fold the rest in half.



Attach folded pieces around small log with points facing up.

Roll clay in hands to soften.



When soft, roll in to a log.



Cut in to about 12 pieces.



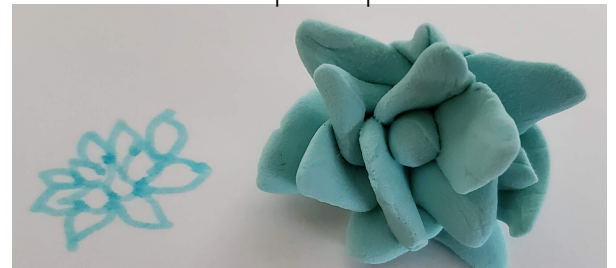
Roll 1 piece in to a log about 1/2 inch long and flatten other pieces to petal shapes.



Pinch one side of each petal to form teardrop shape.



Attach petals around small log with points facing up.




Let the plants air dry.



Place pebbles in jar, then plants on top of pebbles.
